DELIVERABLES FOR THE SAHAPEDIA EXPLORE FELLOWSHIP for Indore

- 1. Cultural Mapping of Indore:** Each fellow is required to research, visit and document at least **15 assets** that are significant markers of the city's culture and heritage. These assets can be from the following themes – Natural Environment, Spaces (Places of Worship, Historical Monuments, Cultural Centres, Public Spaces/Commons, Workspaces/Homes) Public Institutions and Artefacts. The documentation will include researching and coming up with a list of points of interest and selection will be carried out with the Sahapedia team. The fellow will carry out visits, interviews & secondary research to write a description of the chosen site/aspect and make photographs to accompany the written piece. The fellow will be constantly guided in this process by Sahapedia's research team.
- 2. Articles (in English):** Each fellow shall also write 1 article on a museum of the fellow's choice as part of the fellowship. This article can be on the museum as an institution, its establishment and the stories that are associated with it. It can also include information about the artefacts in the museum. The fellow may choose to write about one specific gallery inside chosen museum, or focus on a few artefacts. The theme of the article will be deliberated upon and finalized in consultation with Sahapedia. **Min. Length: 2500-3000 words**

The article must be accompanied with between 15-20 images. A writing guideline, style guide and image guide will be provided to assist you.
