

## Cancellation of the Grant

Both, Sahapedia and the Grantee, have the right to terminate the Grant at any point of time. The Grant may stand cancelled under any or all of the following circumstances:

- Non-submission of deliverables in the prescribed format within the given timeline.
- Delivery of substandard work, lacking quality and research.
- If any part of the deliverables is found to be already published on other platforms prior to the publication of the Grant on Sahapedia. However, the deliverables may include unpublished images taken in an earlier period, though that number must not exceed more than 20 per cent of the final submitted images.
- If the submitted material is plagiarised from any other source and cannot be attributed to the Grant recipient.
- Failure in upholding civil and respectful behaviour with Sahapedia.
- Prolonged absence or failure to update Sahapedia on progress on the Grant at regular intervals.
- If the Grantee decides to cancel the grant due to unforeseen circumstances or personal reasons.

Cancellation of the Grant, for any of the above reasons, will lead to non-release of any further payments and the Grantee must return to Sahapedia any funding previously received. In such a case, if the Grantee has already made submission of any work, that work will stand void and will not be used by Sahapedia in future. However, the Grantee can withdraw only till the time of signing of Copyright License Agreement, after which the Grant will be considered complete.
